The treble clef is used for the flute, oboe, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, french horn and mallet percussion.


The bass clef is used for the trombone, baritone, bassoon, tuba, and timpani.

The piano uses both clefs.


Musical sounds (low or high) are shown by the position of notes on the staff.

Notes are named after the first seven letters of the alphabet – A, B, C, D, E, F, G.
